I would like these broken down by hospital site if you cover more than one hospital.

I would like the details of each incident to include:

- a) the date it occurred (or, if this is not easily possible, the date it was declared) We have given you the month that the incident occurred as we believe that any further information would allow individual patients to be identified.
- b) a description of the incident (I appreciate details of individual patients may need to be redacted, but would like as much detail as you deem possible, e.g. for example "a male patient aged 65", or "a female patient aged 60-65") We have given you a brief outline of the incident, redacting where necessary. We believe that by disclosing the age or age range the patient could be identified as the incidents relate to individual patients.
- c) the outcome of the incident (ie what negative consequences followed), and This information could identify the patient so we are not providing it.
- d) the outcome of the internal investigation into the incident, including whether any disciplinary action has been taken. This information could identify the patient so we are not providing it. We do not record whether any disciplinary action has been taken on the database.

We are using an exemption under section 40(2) of the FOI act ie data protection.
