

Who we are

We are a team of NHS staff who provide emotional and spiritual care for patients, their carers and relatives and for staff.

You do not have to be religious to use this service and we provide help and emotional support whatever the circumstances.

The team consists of paid chaplains, volunteers and representatives of other major world faiths.

We are all experienced in health chaplaincy and are employed by the Trust. As with all staff we can be identified by our official badges and follow strict confidentiality rules.

We can offer different kinds of help including:

Spiritual care

We recognise that illness not only affects people's bodies – it affects our whole lives. Spiritual care explores hope and fears, sources of meaning and strength and the relationships and concerns that matter most in your life.

You may find it helpful to talk to someone who has time to listen and is experienced in supporting people in hospital.

We offer:

- A listening ear
- Confidentiality
- Acceptance
- Support

Religious support

Chaplains can help meet your religious needs while you are in hospital.

There are multi faith prayer rooms in each hospital which open for personal use – both for private prayer and as a quiet space.

Muslim Friday prayers are said each week at the prayer room at both the Alexandra Hospital and at Worcestershire Royal Hospital.

There is a Christian service at the Alexandra hospital every Tuesday morning.

As the chaplaincy team we offer:
