

EVESHAM THEATRE

Evesham Community Hospital has one day surgery theatre, providing a day surgery service for patients undergoing general surgery, gynaecology, oral surgery, urology and pain procedures.

The theatre provides a surgical service between Monday and Friday and has a dedicated team of theatre practitioners and support workers led by a Theatre Team Leader and supported by the Clinical Theatre Manager at Worcestershire Royal Hospital.

As a registered practitioner in theatre, you will care for day surgery patients undergoing a variety of surgical and endoscopic procedures throughout their perioperative journey as an:

- Anaesthetic practitioner
- Scrub practitioner
- Circulating practitioner
- Recovery practitioner

As a support worker in theatre, you will assist the registered practitioners with perioperative care

All members of staff in theatre receive mandatory Trust training every year and there are a wide range of e-learning modules for all staff to complete and opportunities to complete training to support their individual roles
